

Report for week ending 9-27-02

1. Keith Conway created the nucleus of the 2-Kilo editor. The User Interface is quite rough at this point and he hasn't built in the safeguards to keep it from crashing, but most of the basic functionality is there. It creates, modifies and displays 2-Kilo's.
2. Keith contacted 3-M once again and should get a return call on Monday regarding access to ships CSMP. I discussed with Charlie Littleton, the access that both we and LCE Norfolk currently have to the CDMD-OA and 3M data bases. What we have is a username and password that allows us to use the software that resides at those locations. What we will need for FAST is different. We need read-only access to the actual data so that FAST can manipulate it (especially SCLISIS data) and display it in FAST. I don't think anyone wants so shut down FAST, log into CDMD-OA and/or RAMIS, get the information, copy it down and transfer it into FAST. We all want that to be seamless and automatic. For that to happen, we need a different level of access to these data bases. THAT is what Keith is requesting and what we may need some Government assistance to get.
3. Keith gave Laura Hewitt at NWAS a call as directed, but we have not heard back from her.
4. Chandler Gable continued to research the requirements for the CK editor and the CK development process.
5. The date and time has been set for the Critical Design Review in Norfolk. It will be at 0800 on Thursday October 17th at FTSLANT.
6. It is requested that the five or six people that will be participating in the User Interface working group be identified quickly because we would like to conduct that meeting 8-9 October.
