

Report for week ending 05-23-03

COMMON ASSESSMENT TOOL - FAST

1. This week, the Total Ship Readiness Assessment (TSRA) wrapped up on USS Port Royal in Pearl Harbor. The visit was a challenge in many respects, but in the end a good product was given to the ship. During the visit, the process for documenting discrepancies and maintenance actions evolved and we made changes to FAST to support this new process.
2. The PSART visit on the USS Russell started in Hawaii this week as well. FAST was used to write 2-Kilos and make reports for this visit. The PSART visit will wrap up next week.
3. The C5RAs on USS Germantown and USS Jarrett start on Tuesday, May 27th. FAST will be used as the Visit Management software for these visits as well as the four other C5RAs in June.
4. Training continues this week at FTSCPAC. We are now training Code 200, Code 400 and SEMAT personnel in addition to Code 300 folks that missed the training last month.
5. Keith Conway is in Pearl this week making modifications to FAST as the TSRA process changes.
6. Chandler Gable has been working with FTSC/LANT on the Standard Statements and the initiative to create an INSURV module to meet their requirements.
